When you share information about yourself on a dating app Because you don't want to risk seeming strange in any way 😑 You don't want to scare anyone away Your profile looks like every other guy 💮 Doesn't represent you There is a temptation to use generic info The problem is that you don't stand out This is why most guys are disappointed with dating apps Girls who are worth knowing are looking for something different They don't get attention that they want 

But it is because they don't have an attention-worthy profile 1. Avoid lists of any kind Associate each piece of info with an action 💮 "My fave music: Moby for rainy days, U2 for traffic jams, D'Angelo for dates" in shape have a special skill Something that will hint that you are... make good money at your job did something really cool in the past 👵 i.e. went on safari in Africa 2. Share info using mini-stories Upper floor: white collar, good job Never miss a chance for a "subtle positive" Gives positive picture | Takes the stairs: in shape Trick: Find the positives in your job 🕒 Every job has a positive Example: be purposely vague 🕞 "I work on the 14th floor (I take the stairs sometimes)" Profile basics Being vague gives her an easy open: 

"So what do you do on the 14th floor?" Rule #1: Don't play it safe A little bit of mystery and a little bit of fun Sets you apart Plus, you don't sound douche or like you are bragging ("I'm a lawyer") The trick is to not play it safe 1. Goal is to flip a negative into a positive 😑 Flip something you don't like about yourself into something fun and positive 2. Share something that most people don't share 💮 To help set yourself apart "I listen to Marah Carey when I'm jogging" 
(Notice the extra positive: Jogging = in shape) Anti-macho (Cooking= special skill) 

A skill that has value to most women "I wear an apron when I cook" 3. Examples: Even though cooking and aprons might be seen as effeminate Nerdy 😑 "I'm cooler than my thick glasses suggest" 😑 "Don't worry, I'll wear my contacts on our date" 3. Make fun of yourself 
The flip trick Confessional 🕒 "I didn't get my first kiss until I was 18" 🕒 "Don't worry, all the other important firsts followed soon thereafter" Girls often say that they like funny guys, BUT... 

What they mean is that they like fun guys 4. Understand what I mean by humor 💮 You are going for FUN not necessarily funny The goal with the flip trick is to show that you are fun 

You don't take yourself too seriously You can practice not taking yourself too seriously Pre-game: setting up a dating app Secondary benefit of the flip trick The flip trick shows you that this pressure is not necessary Guys put pressure on themselves to perform on a first date A active reminder that you don't have to be perfect, you just have to be fun Pictures are important for social media and today's dating apps 💮 But if you are like most people, you hate how you look in pictures 1. Put your "least bad" pics on your profile 🕞 Most people just choose pics that "don't look terrible" How to start You won't get anyone's attention if you don't have at least one 🕒 Not a viable option at all 2. Don't use any pictures (= Another bad idea: using pics where your face is obscured somehow Options Girls are on the lookout for creeps 

You'll definitely look like a creep without a clear picture This could be an option Get a professional photo shoot But it could also give the impression that you are trying too hard 🕒 Or that you are too self-centered Action shots 

Pictures of you out doing things 

These have to be informal, not posed You need a decent camera and a friend who knows how to use it Have a friend with a camera chronical a night out Let them in on your plan beforehand 🥚 Have them take snaps all evening Pictures of a family event or a "buddies trip" or etc... Picture tricks 2. Use social media pics that you are tagged in Include these in your list of possibilities How to get good action shots 3. Take a selfie when you are standing somewhere interesting 

Or have a passerby take an casual shot of you The more you take, the more options you will have The best (only?) option: Take lots of snapshots Choose the best few 
No more than 4-5 You will be focused on doing things, so you won't have time to worry about appearing awkward 2. You won't be camera shy You will avoid the forced smile, camera-shy look Why is this the best (only?) option? 3. It won't seem like your trying to hard 

You won't have any obviously posed pictures She has an immediate conversation starter if she contacts you . She can comment/ ask about what you are doing in one of your pictures 4. Gives her an open This is more important that you might think 
Make it easy for her to think of something to say Even if she is only semi-interested, she is more likely to make a comment If she has something interesting to comment on I am going to build attraction Always keep the endgame in mind [a] I am going to stand out from other guys Having a strategy in mind 
Important rule: you have to know where you are going! Every text, email, phone call is a chance to build attraction/sexual chemistry Everything on your profile should fit with your end goal Every message you send women should fit with that goal (a) If it doesn't, don't send it The first message The first phone call

How to vet her

Pre-game: setting up a dating app If you have already met her and got her phone # If you have never met her and are contacting her via a dating app The same approach works for any situation 3. If you know her and you are in the friend zone 🕞 But you want to get out of the friend zone 4. If she contacted you first and you want to respond When she has time to talk and is not distracted Timing is not important with texting 😑 If you call, you have to catch her in the right mood It takes less effort to respond to a text than a voicemail Why you should message first (instead of calling) You don't have to worry about freezing up You can edit what you write in a message 💮 But you can't change what you say in a conversation on the phone "Hi. How are you? "What's Up?" A boring first message 


Examples: "Hi. My name is..." "Remember me from last weekend?" The biggest mistake: Something that won't be misunderstood They want a "safe" first message You don't want to seem weird, strange... Why do guys make this mistake? Don't want to take any risk And she finds that uninteresting You may get no response or a lukewarm response 

Because you are just following the script You are just like every other guy who tries to contact her . The truth: if she is worth dating, then lots of guys contact her . You have to stand out from message #1 Something that will stand out First message should be intriguing Something that is not according to the "script" that guys usually use Goal: send her something intriguing that begs a response Imagine your first conversation with her 2. Doesn't matter how it starts Keep going with this imagined conversation 


Past all the "pleasantries" Choose one of the phrases you imagined yourself saying When you get to the middle of the conversation, stop imagining Base your first message on this phrase Start: "so I see you went to Comicon" Pick something from her profile that you can work with 
 Imagine a conversation about this thing Example: "Maybe I saw you at Comicon. I was the handsome guy in the Darth Vader helmet" Imagine to the middle of the conversation...see if anything comes up Doesn't really have to be true... On a dating app Try this: 2. Ask her to choose from two things in her profile, then participate in the choice 😑 "Mango salsa or Moby? I'd give up the sauce before the music, but if I could eat while listening..." 3. OR be playfully self-depreciating 💮 "My friends say I shouldn't admit it, but I liked that Amy Tan book too" 🕒 Add a subtle brag: "I fix cars too, so I am not totally effeminate" The first message This is a bit easier, because you can recall something you said when you met EXAMPLES (a) If you got her # How to start Trick: start in the middle of the script "Ouch, that tequila I bought you... Next time I'll buy you an Advil chaser too" ...You might get a silly answer, but at least you will get an answer "So what's more important, being good-looking or having a good personality?" "People tell me I look like (celebrity name). Who do you look like?" Ask a silly question... Examples: "Are pinky-swears legally binding?" Something that is totally off the wall, but fun "I'm starting a band. Can you learn the bass by this Saturday?" Not sending "Hi, my name is...." 



Often, the next messages will flow naturally You can have fun text banter right from the start There is all sorts of advice about the optimal time to send a message/text 🍵 "Wait three days" or "at least 12 hours..." 1. When you are confident that you have something good to say When to send If you met her and got her #, then you want your encounter to be fresh in her memory The only rules are... 2. Before too long [a] If you found her on a dating app, there is really no reason to wait Also, the longer you wait, the more you are prone to psyching yourself out These rules apply for contacting her via a dating app as well 1. These apps generally provide the same user experience as the desktop site . To get the full slate of tools, you have to be a paying member Plenty of Fish Major examples include Zoosk OK Cupid 1. Profile matters 👵 Follow all the "rules" I set out about setting up a profile Don't put too much stock in the "matching" algorithms on these apps One of the biggest advantages of these major players is their search capabilities 3. Take advantage of search functions You can use them to find girls with unusual interests or hobbies You can also seach for a limited age range 👵 So you can avoid divorcees or sorority girls or whoever.... Some people are looking for casual dates, others for marriage and serious relationships 4. Make sure you and her are on the same page 🕒 These sites have broad appeal Make sure you use the vetting tricks to see where she stands 1. A chance to flirt face to face without actually meeting Basics 5. Try a Skype date 
Casually try a video chat on Skype or Facetime This can help you on a couple of levels 2. A chance to see what she really looks like 🕒 Photos can lie (or they can be from 10 years ago) 3. A chance to use facial and voice flirting 

Something not possible on most apps For example, Plenty of Fish has a "local" tool 🕒 See who is located near you right now 🕒 Similar to Happn 6. Use the extra tools Or, more importantly, who viewed you more than once See who viewed you . With premium account, you can usually see who viewed your profile . To see who might be interested in you without actually "liking" their profile Save them as "favorites" or "likes" without actually taking any action . She won't know that she is a "favorite" 7.
